AN LÒCHRAN



An Lòchran is a state-of-the-art multiple occupancy building co-locating:

- Highlands and Islands Enterprise (HIE) - core teams and Inner Moray Firth area team
- University of the Highlands and Islands (UHI) - key research and education departments
- Scotland's Rural College (SRUC) - research and consultancy divisions

It is also home to:

- SAC consulting and rural business services (Inverness office) - part of the SRUC consultancy division
- #hellodigital - a digital demonstration centre
- Science Skills Academy - raising the enthusiasm of young people for study and careers in science, technology, engineering, mathematics and digital creativity
- Wave Energy Scotland (WES) - supporting wave technology developments
- Scottish Manufacturing Advisory Service (SMAS) - helps companies by designing and delivering tailored manufacturing improvement support
- Interface - connecting businesses with the right Scottish academic expertise
- University of the Highlands and Islands STEM Hub - an innovative teaching facility exciting interest in STEM subjects, and a venue for science events

An Lòchran is Gaelic for lantern. The vision is that the building will be an exemplar of collaborative working, with a number of different organisations co-located in one building with shared central facilities and common areas.

INVERNESS CAMPUS

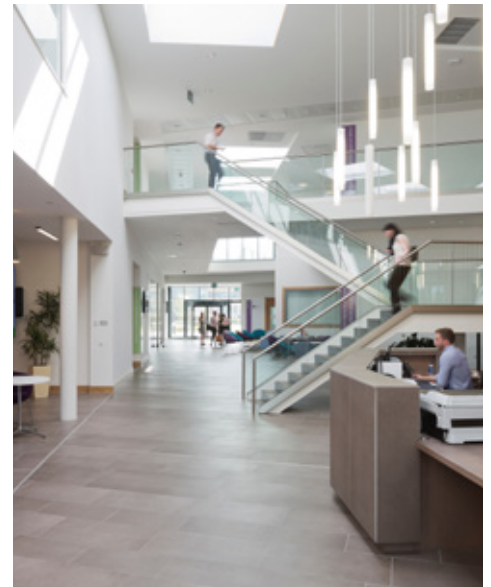
An Lòchran is located at **10** Inverness Campus. The Campus has created a home where business, research and teaching organisations can work collaboratively, with a particular focus on Life Sciences.

It also provides a stunning environment for learning and a generous, well-designed public park.

Developed by Highlands and Islands Enterprise, the 215-acre Inverness Campus has a variety of fully serviced plots available for development.

Inverness Campus is part of the city's Life Sciences district with major health facilities and businesses such as Raigmore Hospital, the Centre for Health Science and LifeScan Scotland just a short walk away.

The site is well served by public transport and features an excellent network of footpaths and cycle ways.





GETTING TO INVERNESS CAMPUS

On foot: The Campus is approximately a 25 minute (3km walk) from Inverness city centre.

By bike: Inverness Campus is easily accessed by bicycle. The site has priority for pedestrians and cyclists on the shared surfaces and also features a network of cycle paths. The Campus can be accessed from the east (from Inverness Retail and Business Park) and west (Raigmore) by means of dedicated pedestrian and cycle bridges. Bike parking is available to the rear of the An Lòchran building.

By bus: There is a bus every 15 minutes from the city centre.

- 1B, 2, 2A and 3 leave from Falcon Square.
- 11U and 25U travel directly to the campus from Nairn and Invergordon respectively.

The Campus bus stop is a 400m flat walk from An Lòchran.

By train: Inverness Rail Station is in the city centre. From the city centre visitors can walk, take a taxi or bus to Inverness Campus. In addition www.bikeandgo.co.uk operate cycle hire from the station.

By taxi: There is a taxi rank in Inverness city centre on Academy Street by the rail station. Inverness Campus is approximately a 10 minute journey from the city centre.

Please ensure that your driver is aware of the exact location of An Lòchran at **10** Inverness Campus.

In your car: If arriving from the north – take the Culloden/Raigmore Hospital exit off the A9. Keep in the right hand lane on the slip road. The main entrance to the Campus is straight ahead at the traffic lights which you meet at the top of the slip road.

If arriving from the south – take the Raigmore Hospital/Culcabock exit off the A9 towards Inshes roundabout. At the roundabout take the first exit. After crossing the flyover over the trunk road, at the traffic lights take the first left onto Inverness Campus.

GETTING TO AN LÒCHRAN

Once on the Inverness Campus, follow the numbered signage to An Lòchran which is at no. **10**.

At the mini roundabout, take the second exit (straight on) down the tree lined avenue. This is signposted 'all other directions'. (If using the Campus overspill car park this is located at the third exit of the roundabout).

Follow the avenue for 350m, as it curves around the small loch you will see a green and brown building (see image above) on the right at no. **10**. This is An Lòchran.

Parking for vehicles and cycles is at the rear of the building.

PARKING

Accessible car parking is available to the rear of An Lòchran. Signposting delineates parking for staff and visitors to each key partner in the building. Should this be full, please use the 100-space overspill car park located at the entrance to the Campus, some 400m from An Lòchran.

Please do not park at the front of An Lòchran - we would like to keep Inverness Campus looking as good as it did the day it opened to the public. Fly parking at the Campus has already damaged some of the Caithness stone slab areas and we'd like to avoid this happening again.

ON ARRIVAL

When you arrive at An Lòchran please make your way to the reception desk which is situated opposite the café.

CATERING

An Lòchran has an onsite café which is open between 8am and 4pm and serves a variety of hot and cold breakfasts, lunches and snacks.
