Both trainee and practising teachers can make use of the Royal Society of Biology's careers lesson resources to help demonstrate certain Teachers' Standards, as defined by the Department of Education¹, and support their own professional development.

Teachers' Standard	
<p><i>1 Set high expectations which inspire, motivate and challenge pupils</i></p>	<p>Create a stimulating environment for pupils using the resources and careers-related activities.</p> <p>Inspire by showcasing different career pathways that stretch and challenge pupils.</p>
<p><i>3 Demonstrate good subject and curriculum knowledge</i></p>	<p>Extend depth and breadth of your own knowledge with the resources, and demonstrate a critical understanding of bioscience applications and careers to maintain pupils' interest in the subject.</p>
<p><i>4 Plan and teach well-structured lessons</i></p>	<p>Use the resources to integrate information about bioscience careers into lessons and contribute to an engaging curriculum.</p>
<p><i>8 Fulfil wider professional responsibilities</i></p>	<p>Contribute positively to the wider life of your school with your understanding of bioscience careers, including supporting pupils with UCAS applications.</p>
